The next meeting of the African American Genealogy Group of the Miami Valley (AAGGMV) will be Saturday May 22, 1:00 P.M. at the downtown Cincinnati and Hamilton County Main Library, 800 Vine St., Cincinnati, OH 45202, room 3B.

The topic will be: “Death Notices and Obituaries for African American Genealogical Research.” The guest speaker will be Mr. Denis Daly of the library's Genealogy Department. Mr. Daly holds a BA and MA in American history and has been a reference librarian in the History and Genealogy Department since 2001. His background in African American history, combined with his work, has led him to acquire an extensive knowledge of African American genealogy.

Our interactive discussion will include the use of the library's “Wi-Fi” and computer projector for visual screening of research aids. Attendees are encouraged to bring their laptop or notebook computers for one-on-one assistance.

A short business meeting will follow the formal meeting's presentations.

The meeting is free and open to the public. All are welcome.
